

9 Top Beach Bargains for 2017

Flee the icy winter conditions up north and retreat to these warmer, tropical hot spots.

Each winter, snowbirds escape the icy conditions of the East Coast to relax and recharge at sunny, laid-back beach towns across tropical locales in the U.S, Mexico and the Caribbean. Leaving the dreary winter days far behind them, travelers seek azure waters, sun-drenched sands and swaying palms. And happily for those craving a reprieve from frosty temperatures, beach resorts are enticing sun-seekers with a variety of promotions and discounts. So, if you're ready to enjoy the surf and sand, and leave extra layers and inclement weather behind, slip away to these affordable beach retreats.

Fort Myers and Sanibel Island, Florida

If you're looking to steer away from the crowds at popular Florida destinations, consider this affordable, off-the-beaten-path locale in the Sunshine State. Known for its world-class shelling, Sanibel's waves catch incoming shells of all shapes, varieties and colors. And with more than 100 islands, outdoor enthusiasts can explore the area by water.
